History of College

1958

Milestones in the history of Rangaraya Medical College

1. The college became a reality on 2nd April 1958 in a meeting in Kakinada attended by Sri Neelam Sanjeeva Reddy, the then Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh, where the Maharajah of Pithapuram gave consent to start the Medical College in an orphanage building complex being run by him on Pithapuram road of Kakinada.
2. "Kakinada Medical Education Society" was registered on 16th April 1958 to oversee the starting of the Medical College.
3. In June 1958, Andhra University officials inspected the pre-clinical departments and gave permission for starting of the new 'Sri Rangaraya Memorial Medical College' for a period of two years.
4. The college started on 17 September 1958 with the introductory speech of Dr. V.S. Krishna, Vice Chancellor of Andhra University.
5. Officially the college was started by the then Chief Minister and Minister of Health of Andhra Pradesh Sri Neelam Sanjeeva Reddy on 17 November 1958.
6. On 14 October 1959 Government of Andhra Pradesh notified the existing District Head Quarters Hospital in Kakinada as the Teaching Hospital attached to the Rangaraya Medical College.
7. Vice president of India Sri Sarvepalli Radhakrishna laid the foundation stone for the Anatomy and Physiology block 04 August 1961.
8. The college name was changed to 'Rangaraya Medical College' in 1961
9. World renowned scientist Dr. J.B.S. Haldane donated his body to the Pathology department of this college for scientific research in 1964.
10. Diploma courses were started in five disciplines in 1972.
11. Post graduate degree courses in all disciplines were started in 1976-77
12. Government of Andhra Pradesh took over the college administration on 30 April 1977 by a Special ordinance.
13. Super-specialty courses were started in the year 2012.
14. In addition to medical courses, the college runs Nursing degree courses, and para-medical courses. The Hospital runs General Nursing courses.
